Western Wisconsin Health Community Trail Information

Providing our community with a trail close to home will not only encourage and increase activity but could potentially boost economic growth as we add more trails that connect throughout Baldwin. Trail use can also contribute to lower annual health care costs due to fewer cases of heart and lung disease, and other diseases associated with less physical activity. We are very hopeful that our campus trails are just the beginning to the addition of more trail systems community wide.

We plan to mow and maintain the path this summer and seed the trail in the fall of 2019. By the summer of 2020, the trails would include benches, mile markers and naming opportunities. Our annual 5K race would kick-off the “Grand Opening” of the trail in June.

- **Summer/Fall 2019** – mowed trail(s) with any seeding that may be needed. Approximately 1 ½ miles of trails that lead to Wintergreen Park.
- **Summer 2020** – have established mowed trails with benches, mile markers and naming opportunities. Possible addition of Fitness Center equipment. Grand Opening that coincides with annual race.
- **Future** - Work with Baldwin on more trails (some paved) to offer a variety of safe walking trails for our community (not just on our campus). We hope our WWH trails are just the starting point for a full trail system with connections around St. Croix County.

We are very excited to move forward with our campus Community Trail project and hope that you are inspired to help us achieve this new initiative for community wellness! Our mission is to inspire our community to work together to build a healthier tomorrow and we appreciate your consideration in helping us achieve this goal.
